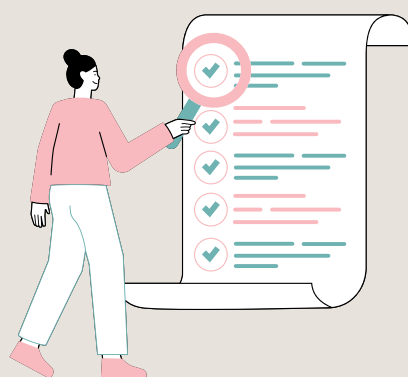


1. About the Project

Upskill and Reconnect empowers young people (15–19 years), including those with fewer opportunities, to become mentors for seniors in the digital world. Through volunteering and intergenerational learning, they build real-life skills and become more confident, responsible, and employable citizens.

2. Building Youth Capacity

Youth workers will be trained to help young volunteers develop key competencies—communication, teamwork, leadership, and mentoring. Each partner country will engage 3 youth workers, 30 young people, and 30 seniors to take part in hands-on digital skill training.



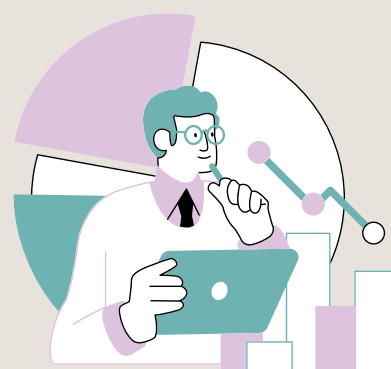
3. Mentorship Program for Youth

A dedicated program will prepare young people to support seniors in acquiring essential digital skills. Through Living Labs, youth and seniors will connect, collaborate, and exchange knowledge—building bridges between generations.



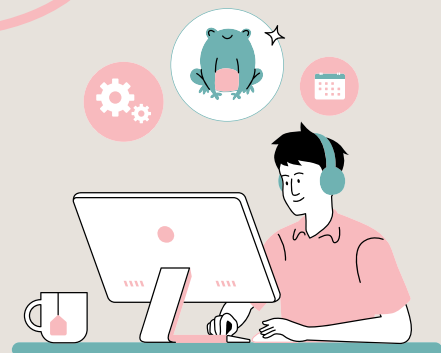
4. Youth Workers Training

Each partner country will send 3 youth workers to participate in international training. They'll learn how to equip young volunteers with the tools and techniques for mentoring seniors effectively in a digitally evolving society.



5. Senior Hackathons

National hackathons will allow teams of trained seniors to compete using their newly acquired digital skills—like online banking, safe browsing, or digital photo management. Youth workers will guide the organization using a step-by-step guidebook.



6. Final Events & Dissemination

A youth exchange and final conference in Bosnia will bring together project participants to share success stories. Top-performing seniors and young mentors will present their achievements. Local dissemination events will follow in all partner countries.
